Three Bean Press currently has three children's titles on the market:

Frankie Goes to Fenway: The Tale of the Faithful, Red Sox-Loving Mouse is the trio's popular baseball story. Frankie is a field mouse from Vermont who moves to Fenway Park. He finds happiness there until a New York cat moves to town and the Red Sox's winning streak suddenly ends. It's up to Frankie to save the day.

Lily + the Imaginary Zoo is the tale of a young girl who runs errands throughout Boston with her mother. Along the way, she encounters many of the city's beloved animal sculptures, and they spring to life through the power of her imagination, making for an unforgettable day. Children can follow Lily's Trail via the book's map to see the animals on their own.

The Yellowest Yellow Lab is a fun rhyming book for young kids and dog lovers. It's a playful poem about a big dog who is afraid of everything; but the magic is, his very presence makes his family feel safe.

The company collaborated with **The Charles Hotel** in Cambridge, Mass., on the creation and publication of a cookbook by Chef **Peter Davis** with **Alexandra Hall** called ***Fresh & Honest: Food From the Farms of New England and the Kitchen of Henrietta's Table***, released in November 2008.

Three Bean Press is now publishing books for other authors and establishments, with several scheduled for release this year.
